Veterans Upward Bound (VUB) is a free-of-charge program that helps veterans, who have not completed a bachelor's degree, prepare for enrollment at the college of their choice.

VUB assists veterans across Maine, regardless of school of choice, who are beginning or returning to post-secondary education. The program is tailored to meet individual needs in a variety of ways including the following areas:

- Assistance in completing college admission and financial aid applications
- Academic & skills assessment
- Tutoring and computer-based instruction
- Academic, financial aid, career and personal counseling
- Classroom instruction in reading, writing, and math, as well as computer basics, study skills, and other essential subjects

Eligibility

I am a U.S. military veteran who served at least 181 consecutive days on active-duty

OR

was activated from a reserve component of the Armed Forces for more than 30 days

AND

- I had any discharge except dishonorable
- I do not have a four-year college degree
- I would like help in preparing for the school of my choice

Veterans Upward Bound is 100% federally funded at \$263,938 annually
